BOOK STUDY "Appreciate These Things" start Friday, **May 2** - In Person, 9:30 - 10:30 or on Zoom 11am - noon. Cost is \$20 a book to Don Strangway. In a world tense with anger and division, how can we preserve our sense of well-being and inject a little more kindness into our daily interactions? The answer is in Philippians 4:8: "Whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is pleasing, whatever is commendable, if there is any excellence and if there is anything worthy of praise, think about these things." Thinking about, looking for, appreciating these eight things can reorient our hearts and minds in ways that nurture compassion for ourselves, those in need, and those with whom we are inclined to disagree.

We recently completed a very meaningful Cluster Book Study: See no Stranger by Valarie Kaur. This book by Omar el Akkad would give us some insight in to how the rest of the world views the Western Nations (us), which might be depressing but also instructive. As Christians, we are also part of our society. The book costs about \$20.00. Let me know if you are interested and I will order the book, set up a zoom invitation list and "get going". We might go mid May to late June: no book study over the summer.
